SPECTACLE OF LEGIONS

RIFT VALLEY LAKE & ITS ENVIRONS

DAY 1: Nairobi – Njoro (Nakuru)

Pick up from your hotel in Nairobi latest 0900 Hours and depart driving North East down the escarpment of the Great Rift Valley. You will take a brief stop at the view point for a few shots of this amazing natural phenomenon.

The history of the Rift Valley dates back to millions of years during great earth movements. This massive valley stretches from the Middle East to Mozambique.



Proceed along the rift valley floor to Nakuru and further on to the high altitude town of Njoro. Arrival at your campsite in time for lunch.

The campsite is located on a working farm overlooking the Great Rift Valley with adequate space to explore the region and relax in a peaceful & friendly environment.

Set up camp and lunch thereafter.

Afternoon at leisure to undertake the various activities on offer which include farm walks, bush & bird walks, visit to the local school and community projects.

Dinner and overnight at **KEMBU CAMPSITE**. (Full Board)

DAY 2: Njoro (Nakuru)

Full day with picnic lunch at Lake Nakuru National Park which is 30 minutes drive from your campsite.

The park is world famous as the location of the greatest bird spectacle on earth - myriads of pink flamingoes whose numbers are legion, often more than a million.

This magnificent park is also famed as one of the best places in Kenya to chance for the elusive Leopard.

Late in the afternoon, return to your campsite for dinner and overnight.

Dinner and overnight at **KEMBU CAMPSITE**. (Full Board)

DAY 3: Njoro (Nakuru)

This day, you will visit the largest volcano caldera in Kenya - Menengai Crater which is 25 minutes drive from the camp.

The main viewpoint of the crater gives you a 270° view of the surrounding area. You will have a guided walk around the crater which features predominantly in the Masai folklore.

Thereafter, return to your campsite for lunch.

Afternoon at leisure. You may opt to get involved in the community tourism projects initiated at the farm which include tree planting, visit to a local school, flower farm or women's group projects. This is highly encouraged as your contributions go a long way in boosting the livelihoods of the local community.

Dinner and overnight at **KEMBU CAMPSITE**. (Full Board)



DAY 4: Njoro - Nairobi

After breakfast, morning at leisure to relax and take it easy. After lunch, depart for Nairobi to arrive late evening. Transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your outbound flight or to your hotel in Nairobi.
