ABERDARES / MERU / MARSABIT / CHALBI DESERT / LAKE TURKANA / MARALAL / LAKE BARINGO

DAY 1: Nairobi Arrival - Aberdares

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (**presumably with an early morning flight**), you will be met by our representative and thereafter a pre safari briefing over breakfast.

Depart Nairobi latest 0900 Hours driving northwards past the rich agricultural farmlands on central Kenya and further on to Aberdares region to arrive at Sandai Home stay & Cottages located on the foot hills of the mountain ranges. Lunch at Sandai Home stay & Cottages.

Afternoon at leisure to relax and familiarize with the surrounding or undertake any of the activities offered at the farm which include guided nature & bird walks, horse riding and visits to the nearby villages. **Payable direct!**

Dinner and overnight at **SANDAI HOMESTAY & COTTAGES**.
(Full Board)

DAY 2: Aberdares National Park

Full day in Aberdares with game drives in Aberdares National Park and Solio Ranch as per your convenience.

Aberdares National Park is a dynamic park known for its majestic peaks of the mountain ranges, deep ravines that cut through the forested eastern & western slopes and a diverse variety of the elusive forest mammals.

Solio Ranch was the first Rhino Sanctuary in Kenya and boasts some of the most dynamic game viewing opportunities.

All meals and overnight at **SANDAI HOMESTAY & COTTAGES**. (Full Board)

DAY 3: Aberdares – Meru National Park

After breakfast, depart with picnic lunch driving northwards past the equator and on through the expansive ranch lands of Laikipia to arrive Meru National Park late afternoon.





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Meru is part of a complex of protected areas along the Tana River that includes the adjacent Bisanadi and Mwingi National Reserves, Kora National Park and Rahole National Reserve. The diverse habitat in the parks is home to a wide variety of wild game. Birdlife is also abundant with a record of over 350 species.

Game drive enroute to your lodge renowned for being one of the most elegant lodges in Africa.

Dinner and overnight at **ELSA'S KOPJE**. (Full Board)

DAY 4: Meru National Park

Full day in Meru National Park with morning and afternoon game drives as per your convenience. Other activities (**payable direct**) on offer include guided walks, night game drives, sundowners, cultural visits and line fishing.

All meals and overnight at **ELSA'S KOPJE**. (Full Board)

DAY 5: Meru - Shaba National Reserve

After breakfast, depart driving further north towards Samburu to arrive at Joy's Camp in time for lunch. The camp is named after the world renowned conservationist Joy Adamson who dedicated most of her conservation work in this part of the country.

Afternoon game drive in Shaba National Reserve. Other available activities and **payable direct** include guided bush walks, transfers to cultural villages and trips to the nearby crater.

Dinner and overnight at **JOY'S CAMP**. (Full Board)

DAY 6: Shaba National Reserve

Full day in Shaba with morning and afternoon game drives in Shaba National Reserve situated within the land of the colourful Samburu people who are close cousins of the Masai.

Scenically and faunally dramatic, for most of the year, Shaba is surely under the unsympathetic equatorial sun.





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The park boasts some of the most fascinating landscapes making it very popular with filmmakers and artists alike. The splendor of the landscape is awe inspiring!

All meals and overnight at **JOY'S CAMP**. (Full Board)

DAY 7: Shaba - Marsabit

After breakfast, proceed further north with picnic lunches to arrive at Marsabit Lodge late afternoon. Game drive in Marsabit National Park enroute to the lodge.

This less visited northern reserve is worldly renown as the last refuge of one of the largest elephant ever recorded in the country.

Dinner and overnight at **MARSABIT LODGE**. (Full Board)



DAY 8: Marsabit - Chalbi

Early morning game drive as per your convenience. After breakfast, depart driving through the chalbi desert to arrive in time for lunch at Kalacha Camp located on the edge of a permanent oasis, fed by a natural artesian well.

Afternoon at leisure to undertake the various activities on offer which include: sundowners on the edge of the lava flows, walks around the oasis & in the town, visits to the nearby rock paintings and visits to the Gabbra village.

The area is famous for Sand grouse. Early in the morning huge flocks of Sand grouses arrive at water holes.

Dinner and overnight at **KALACHA CAMP**. (Full Board)



DAY 9: Chalbi - Turkana

After breakfast, proceed driving west towards Turkana to arrive at Oasis Lodge in time for Lunch.



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The lodge is nestled amongst the Doum Palms in the semi desert of northern Kenya, near Lake Turkana.

Afternoon at leisure. Some of the activities available and **payable direct** are: day trips to Mt. Kulal, boat trips to South Island, fishing for Nile Perch and visits to the El Molo & Turkana traditional villages.

Dinner and overnight at **OASIS LODGE**. (Full Board)

DAY 10: Turkana

Full day in Lake Turkana at leisure to undertake the various activities on offer.

Commonly referred as the Jade Sea, the lake is set in the rugged moons-cape of the Great Rift Valley; an area tortured over the eons by immense volcanic activity. It is the place where mankind was born. It is a place for the traveller not the tourist.

All meals and overnight at **OASIS LODGE**. (Full Board)

DAY 11: Turkana - Maralal

Early departure with picnic lunch to arrive late afternoon at Maralal Lodge.

Maralal Safari Lodge is a delightful tourist-class lodge situated in the Maralal game sanctuary just a few kilometers from the colourful frontier town of Maralal, meeting place of the Samburu and Turkana people.



Dinner and overnight at **MARALAL SAFARI LODGE**. (Full Board)

DAY 12: Maralal

Full day in Maralal to undertake the chunk of activities on offer to include visit the town centre, visit to the Samburu Manyatta, visit to the house of the first president of the country (where he was interned), sundowner at Losiolo, game viewing in the reserve, visit to Barsaloi or visit to the Italian mission.



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All meals and overnight at **MARALAL SAFARI LODGE**. (Full Board)

DAY 13: Maralal – Lake Baringo

After breakfast, drive to Lake Baringo to arrive in time for lunch at Lake Baringo Country Club. Afternoon at leisure. There are various activities that can be undertaken at the lodge to include: boat rides, nature walks, visit to the basalt cliffs and nearby Njemps village (**all payable direct**).

Dinner and overnight at **LAKE BARINGO COUNTRY CLUB**. (Full Board)

DAY 14: Lake Baringo – Nairobi Departure

Depart Lake Baringo after breakfast with picnic lunch for Nairobi to arrive late afternoon. Transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your out bound flight.
